- **ALWAYS** engage the **Trigger Lock on the spray gun** before removing the spray gun for hand operation.
- **NEVER** place your hands or any body parts in front of the spray gun.
- **NEVER** point the spray gun at or spray other persons or animals.
- NEVER clean the spray tip while it is attached to the spray gun. Remove the spray tip from the gun to clean the tip guard.
- NEVER remove the spray tip while cleaning the pump.
- NEVER use pliers to tighten or loosen high pressure fittings on the outlet side of pump.
- Use only in a well-ventilated area.
- Always consult your Facility Safety and/or Personnel
 Department for specified safety protocols prior to operating this equipment.



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
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
ASSEMBLY & ADJUSTMENT



Step 1: Remove the two rear axle bolts and nuts on the right side of the machine. Discard the nuts and the rear axle bolt only. Note: Keep the front axle bolt for reassembly.



Step 2: Slide the riser into the right side of the frame, and then reinstall the front axle bolt into the welded nut in the riser. Discard the original rear axle bolt. Slide one $\frac{1}{2}$ lock washer, followed by one/ $\frac{1}{2}$ flat washer onto a $\frac{1}{2-13} \times \frac{2-1}{2}$ Bolt. Install the bolt with washers in the rear axle hole, into the nut welded on the riser. Fully tighten both bolts.



Step 3: Slide the rail down onto the riser until about 6" of the riser post shows above the rail receiver. Tighten the two pinch bolts in the rail receiver to secure the rail to the riser.



Step 4: Install the gun mount assembly into the collar carriage using the provided hex wrench. Tighten the screws just enough to hold it in place.




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
ASSEMBLY & ADJUSTMENT CONTINUED



Step 5: Install the downtube in the receiver at the right side of the rail. The plate on the bottom of the downtube should have the bolt hole toward the front of the machine. Adjust the down tube so that the plate is about 4" off the ground and then tighten the star knob.



Step 6: Mount the front guide tube to the bottom of the down tube, with the plastic guide tab and the pivot to the rear as shown. Align the guide tube and down tube plates and then secure them together with a $3/8-16 \times 1-1/4$ " bolt, two flat washers and a 3/8-16 lock nut. Just snug it at this time so that you can align the three guide tabs with an existing line or string later. Mount the rear guide tube to the pivot plate on the rear of the front guide tube with a $1/4-20 \times 1-1/2$ " bolt, two washers and a 1/4-20 lock nut.



Step 7: Remove the spray gun from the gun mount of the machine, and place it in the gun mount of the HashMark MasterTM. Secure it in the gun mount with the gun mount clamp.




Step 8: Roll the carriage back and forth on the rail to make sure that there is no interference with the paint hose. Open the strap holding the coiled paint hose and adjust it if necessary.




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
OPERATION



Step 1: Loosen the screws on the carrier and then raise or lower the gun mount assembly until a 4" wide line is made, when you spray.



Step 2: Unfold the line guide. For a 4" inset, align the outside edge of the line guide with the sideline.



Step 3: Position the machine with the cutout of the rear line guide plate, centered over the goal line and the center of the spray tip at the left edge of the cutout of the center line guide plate. In a continuous motion, squeeze the spray lever and roll the carriage along the rail until it makes contact with the lynchpin. This will result in a 24" hash mark line.

Move the machine forward so that the rear guide is centered over the hash mark you just painted, with the left edge of the guide aligned with the start of that hash mark. Paint the next hash mark, as above and then continue to the next, in the same manner. This will create hash marks 36" apart, on center.




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STOWING PROCEDURE



Step 1: Remove the spray gun from the HashMark MasterTM and place it back into the gun mount of the machine. Remove the lynchpin and roll the carriage and gun mount assembly off of the rail. Rotate the carriage and gun mount assembly 90 degrees, and then roll it back onto the rail. Install the lynchpin through the rail and into the hole in the carriage plate, as shown.



Step 2: Rotate the rear line guide tube upward, and allow it to rest against the front line guide tube, out of the way as shown.

HASH MARK STANDARDS

Hash marks for professional and college fields are located 4" from the sidelines and are 24" in length. Many High School fields are now following many of the NCAA standards. However, some schools still have hash marks touching the sidelines. Follow your local league recommendations for field layout.
